Item Title:Public Hearing on a request from North State Medical Transport for
a Non-Emergency Ambulance Franchise (First Reading)

Specific Action Requested:

That the Board of Commissioners holds a public hearing to grant a non-emergency ambulance franchise to North State Medical Transport for the operation of a medical transportation service in Wake County effective October 8, 2019 for a fiveyear period.

Item Summary:

- Purpose: Request from North State Medical Transport for issuance of a Non-Emergency Ambulance Franchise.
- Background: North State Medical Transport of Raleigh, North Carolina, is requesting the issuance of an ambulance franchise for operation of a non-emergency convalescent-care medical transport service pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 111 of the Wake County Code of Ordinances.

EMS staff have reviewed North State Medical Transport's application for a non-emergency convalescent-care franchise and has determined that Meraki HealthFirst Transport representations are consistent with the requirements of Wake County's ambulance franchise ordinance.

North State Medical Transport requests issuance of this franchise subject to the Department of Emergency Medical Services Deputy Director's finding of "on-the-ground" compliance of North State Medical Transport with Chapter 111 of the Wake County Code of Ordinances, and all applicable state statutes and regulations.

- Board Goal: This action supports routine County operations.
- Fiscal Impact: Award of a convalescent ambulance franchise represents permission to deliver non-emergency ambulance transportation services and does not involve county subsidies or payments. The County will receive \$1,680 for a one-time application fee to be deposited in the County's General Fund.

Additional Information:

There are currently five franchised non-emergency ambulance providers in Wake County including North State Medical Transport.

Because a franchise ordinance requires two readings, if this request is approved by the Board of Commissioners on September 16, 2019, a second reading and approval will be required at the Board's October 7, 2019 meeting.
