RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SIXTH AMENDMENT TO THE JOHNSTON COUNTY/CITY OF RALEIGH INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR THE EXTENSION OF JOHNSTON COUNTY PUBLIC WATER SERVICE TO PRE-DESIGNATED AREAS WITHIN WAKE COUNTY

WHEREAS, North Carolina General Statute §162A-87.3 and Section 12-11-2 of the Wake County Unified Development Ordinance (UDO) allows the extension of adjacent county water and/or sewer lines into another county upon mutual agreement among the two counties; and

WHEREAS, on July 29, 2008, The City of Raleigh and Johnston County executed an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) that authorized Johnston County to extend water service lines into predesignated areas of Wake County for the purpose of serving Johnston County customers along the county line more effectively; and

WHEREAS, five subsequent amendments to the ILA were executed between the City of Raleigh and Johnston County to allow connection to the water service line; and

WHEREAS, the sixth amendment to the ILA provides clarification on properties that may make connection to the Johnston County water service line upon administrative approval by the City of Raleigh and Johnston County; and

WHEREAS, the Sixth Amendment to the ILA satisfies the requirements of the Wake County UDO.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE WAKE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS THAT:

The Sixth Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement between the City of Raleigh and Johnston County to extend public water service to pre-designated areas of Wake County is hereby approved.
