NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT Wake County will hold a public hearing to receive comments from interested parties on the County's Housing and Community Development needs. The hearing will be on Monday, December 2, 2019 at 5:00 PM in the Wake County Justice Center Boardroom, 300 South Salisbury Street, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Room 2700, Raleigh, NC.

The purpose of this public hearing is to receive comments from interested parties on: the County's housing and community development needs, barriers to fair housing, and the citizen participation process related to these issues. Wake County will use the information received to prepare the draft 2020-2025 Consolidated Plan and 2020 Action Plan. The Consolidated Plan and Action Plan are required for the County to receive funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The 2020 Consolidated Plan defines priority populations and describes the activities to be carried out during fiscal years 2020-2025 within Wake County, outside of Raleigh. The Action Plan describes the activities to be carried out during fiscal year 2020 from July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021 in the same geographic area. It is the first part of the five-year strategy to meet the County's housing and community development goals as identified in the Consolidated Plan.
