Interim Operations Plan

Wake County Sheriff's Office

- Schedule & oversee law enforcement agencies
- Conduct law enforcement training exercises
- Manage schedule within allocated hours

N.C. Wildlife Resources Commission (WRC)

- Manage, operate and schedule public use of the range (non-law enforcement)
- Manage schedule within allocated hours

Agreement: Wildlife Resources Commission

County provides in-kind use of the facility to WRC

 WRC plans to provide recreational public use of the range at no cost to the public, but may charge reasonable fees in the future

Proposed date to reopen to the public is March 15, 2020

Initial agreement will be up to 12 months
