Proposed Activities CDBG: \$1,258,790

Funding to support Wake County COVID-19 initiatives and grants made to community service partner agencies for the purposes of:

- Housing assistance payments (rent, mortgage, and/or utilities)
- Emergency home maintenance and rehabilitation
- Affordable housing rehabilitation
- Emergency public housing maintenance
- Meal and medicine delivery
- Related administrative and delivery costs

Amendment 2

Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG): COVID-19

Proposed Activities ESG: \$626,800

Funding to support Wake County COVID-19 initiatives and grants made to community service partner agencies for the purposes of:

- Street outreach (urgent needs, equipping staff, transportation, and referrals)
- Rapid re-housing
- Homelessness prevention
- Shelter operations (supplies, furnishing, equipment and transportation)
- Related administrative and delivery costs

HOPWA: COVID-19

Proposed Activities HOPWA: \$132,656

Funding to support Wake County COVID-19 initiatives and grants made to community service partner agencies for the purposes of:

- Rental assistance and short-term payments to prevent homelessness
- Assessment & case management
- Substance abuse treatment
- Mental health treatment
- Nutritional services
- Assistance with daily living
