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III. Update on the Upper Neuse River Basin Alliance *Nancy Daly, Environmental Services*

The Upper Neuse River Basin Alliance (UNRBA) is a collaboration among several counties and municipalities promoting innovative approaches to water quality planning and management. In 2020, the alliance initiates a study of Falls Lake nutrient loads and ways for localities to coordinate on regulatory compliance. Staff will brief the Board on the water quality issues, regulatory framework, and potential next steps. Staff will also ask the Board to consider a budget consideration to fund next steps. No budget appropriation will be made during the work session, but Commissioners will receive the information, ask questions, and provide feedback to staff.
