The purpose of this public hearing is to receive comments from interested parties on the County's housing and community development needs. Wake County will use the information received to prepare the draft 2021 Action Plan. The Action Plan is required for the County to receive funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The Action Plan describes the activities to be carried out from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022 in Wake County, outside of Raleigh. The Action Plan goals are to increase and preserve affordable housing, address policy barriers to housing affordability, and support vulnerable populations and communities through activities address the needs outlined below:

Priority One:

- Households earning 0-50% AMI
- Vulnerable populations experiencing or at-risk homelessness

Priority Two:

- Households earning 51-60% AMI
- Vulnerable populations not experiencing homelessness

Priority Three:

- Households earning 61-80% AMI
