

RESOLUTION DECLARING THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS INTENT TO CLOSE THE RIGHTS-OF-WAY OF TECH ROAD AND DAFFODIL DRIVE AND TO SET A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE QUESTION FOR MARCH 1, 2021

WHEREAS, the adoption of this resolution by the Board of Commissioners is required by North Carolina General Statutes prior to holding a public hearing to consider the closure of the public rights-of-way for Tech Road and Daffodil Drive;

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Department of Transportation has indicated that their abandonment of the roadways from their active road maintenance program in February 2021 has voided all of their "control and supervision" interest in the subject rights-of-way;

WHEREAS, Wake Tech's Board of Trustees has indicated that the closure of these rights-of-way are necessary to accommodate the construction of a traffic circle at the Tech Road and Daffodil Drive intersection to address increased traffic flow and resultant safety concerns;

WHEREAS, the two remaining residential property owners on Daffodil Drive are supportive of this effort;

WHEREAS, the planning staff will ensure that all legal advertisement/notification requirements are adhered to prior to holding the public hearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE WAKE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS:

The Board declares its intent to close the rights-of-way for Tech Road and Daffodil Drive) and calls for a public hearing on the question to be held on March 1st, 2021.

Commissioner Evans made a motion that the above resolution be adopted as part of the Board's consent agenda, and Commissioner Thomas seconded the motion, and upon vote, the motion carried this 1st day of February 2021.
