Preserving the affordability of affordable housing units is a critical element of a comprehensive housing strategy. III. American Rescue Plan Act of 2021

The American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 appropriates an array of funding to help state and local governments respond to the COVID crisis and mitigate the pandemic's economic impacts.
