- ▶ Feb 2021 USIUSF Letter of Intent to Bid sent to FISU
- ► June 2021 Daejeon, South Korea Announces Competing Bid
- ► Sept 1, 2021 FISU opens international phase of bid process
- Sept 1, 2021 Both North Carolina and S. Korea pay bid fee and enter international competition
- ▶ Jan 2022 Field of bidders finalized
- ▶ Jan 2023 Host Cities for 2027 and 2029 announced


